KeyMacro is a macro recorder, and works with the Windows clipboard. It is a small application that records keystrokes as a batch file or a text file. Once the file is created, you can edit the text, add logic to run before each recorded keystroke, or add actions to be performed on the keystrokes. So, for instance, you can create a macro to automatically open a web browser to a website on a particular date, or to check your email, or to open the address bar of your browser to a specific website, for example. You can also create a macro to perform an action on a particular keystroke, for example to automatically close the application you are currently running. This type of macros are quite handy when you want to eliminate repetitive tasks. KEYMACRO also has an AutoRecord mode that automatically records your keystrokes without any further action. Once a macro is created, you can choose to run it immediately, at a specific date, or whenever you want. KEYMACRO also allows you to record mouse clicks and pointer movements, too. You can even use a macro to run the mouse clicks on your desktop, and delete the cursor's path on the screen. The program comes with all of the basic tools you need to use KeyMacro, including a simple interface. You can easily record keystrokes, check the result, add actions to be performed, create date macros, and save the recorded macros as text files or batch files. Its main drawback is that it records every keystroke, regardless of whether you want it to. Some people might find it frustrating, but many find it an interesting feature. KEYMACRO comes in a standard, free version, which includes one user and 20 minutes of recording time. The registration is simple and easy, and it only requires your email address. Once you've registered, you can start using KeyMacro with the following features: • Reads and writes text files and records text, including the clipboard. • Automatically records mouse clicks and pointer movements. • Allows you to choose which window to record. • Has an AutoRecord mode. • Allows you to create date macros. • Has a web browser recorder. • Has a text editor. • Has a documentation option. • Allows you to add actions to be performed before each recorded keystroke. • Records mouse clicks and pointer movements. • Allows you to delete the cursor's path on the screen.
