He played in the Football League for Huddersfield Town and Stoke City. He later played non-League football for Tunbridge Wells Town and Stafford Rangers. Career Molyneux was born in Southampton and began his career at Huddersfield Town, breaking into the first team in 1971. He was a regular goalkeeper for a long time, despite not performing particularly well in his first season. He remained as the club's first choice goalkeeper for many years and was with the club during their FA Cup semi-final defeat to Leeds United in 1980. He also won an FA Cup runners-up medal in 1980. He was transferred to Stoke City in 1980, making 23 league appearances as the "Potters" won promotion in 1980–81. The following season he was used more as cover, with Keith Peacock and Molyneux being the first-choice pairing. His only appearance for the first team was a 3–1 win over Mansfield Town in the 1983 Football League Cup. He left Stoke at the end of the season and returned to his native South Africa. He later played in the South African National Soccer League for Richmond Hill. He also made one appearance for Leyton Orient in 1988.
