Q: Modified Python 2.7 interpreter in Ubuntu 16.04 fails to execute any module I'm trying to run a modified Python interpreter on Ubuntu 16.04 (Python 2.7.13) from and am encountering issues with modules when importing them (e.g. numpy, pandas, scipy, scikit-learn, etc.). I've built the interpreter (from source) using: `./configure --prefix /usr/local make sudo make install` Using Python 2.7.12, the interpreter seems to work fine - modules import normally. However, when I attempt to use a module built from source (e.g. scipy), it fails. For example: `import scipy` returns: `Traceback (most recent call last): File "", line 1, in ImportError: No module named 'scipy'` (Python says it can't find the module even though it's installed. I have the `virtualenv` enabled, and I've confirmed the interpreter is indeed loading the correct environment using the interpreter flag: `PYTHONOPTIMIZE=1 python -c "import sys; print sys.version"` Python 2.7.12+ (default, May 10 2016, 09:04:59) Then the interpreter is using Python 2.7.12, which is when I can't import any modules, for reasons I'm not sure of) How can I properly build the Python 2.7 interpreter so I can run modules? I've done as much as I can to verify that the interpreter is functioning properly before posting this question, but I'm still not able to get the interpreter working. Hopefully this is an issue with a misconfigured build, and not a problem with my environment (at least that seems more likely, but would still be helpful to know). A: It seems that `scipy` is a `python-dev` package. To install it just type `sudo apt-get install python-scipy` It will take a little while, but 4bc0debe42
